To be used when an operator is requesting a new ROW or Surface Use Agreement project on the Southern Ute Indian Reservation located on Tribal Trust Lands. One (1) executed original must be submitted along with an electronic PDF copy and the form must be complete as to the following:

All such Application's for Permission to Survey must be submitted to the Southern Ute Indian Tribe, Department of Energy, PO Box 1500, Ignacio, CO 81137, together with copies of the fees for administrative and filing, to wit:

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The documents will be reviewed by the Southern Ute Indian Tribe Department of Energy Land team for accuracy prior to DOE Manager Approval. Once approved a copy will be sent to the operator and the PTS will go through 10 day PPN (proposed project notification) review after which final comments will be sent to the operator.

Please note that per #5 on the PTS the operator shall notify the lands division 10 working days prior to any survey activities taking place, this 10 day period can run concurrently with the 10 day PPN process mentioned above.

1. Obtain written permission of the Indian landowners to access for surveying purposes under § 169.101(b), and;

2. Notify each affected landowner of its intent to submit a right-of-way or surface use agreement application to the Southern Ute Department of Energy;
3. The applicant(s) understands and expressly agrees to indemnify the United States & Southern Ute Indian Tribe, owners of the land, occupants of the land, against liability for loss of life, personal injury and property damage occurring because of survey activities and caused by the applicant, his employees, contractors and their employees, or subcontractors and their employees;
4. The Applicant(s) **MUST** secure a Tribal Crossing Permit from the Southern Ute Tribal Natural Resources, Lands Division, prior to entering upon and initiating any work on Southern Ute Tribal land, **IF** there is no other document in place authorizing entrance to Tribal land, i.e., oil and gas lease assignments, designation of operator, communitization agreements.
5. The Applicant **MUST** contact the Southern Ute Tribal Natural Resources, Lands Division at 970-563-0100, ext. 2225, 2236 or 2338 **ten (10) working days prior** to any surveying activities being initiated on tribal land. (This is to ensure and verify if tribal “assigned” lands are affected, so that Tribal Assignment Holders may be contacted);
6. The Applicant(s) must be in compliance with the Southern Ute Indian Tribe’s Tribal Employee Rights Office at 970/563-0100 ext. 2291;
7. This survey request will **Expire** in two years from date of approval by the Manager, Department of Energy, Southern Ute Indian Tribe;
